Month	Project
September	Warm Toes: Socks for Nursing Home... bring in a new pair of warm socks for men or women. These will be donated to the nursing home for residents.
October	Cancer Care Packages: We will collect items for the Tommy & Shirley Cancer Center in Vidalia, GA. Items needed are listed on back.
November	Lend A Hand for Personal Care: Collect personal care items for nursing home residents. These items should be new. Items such as: puzzle books, lotions, tissues, deodorant, toothpaste, tooth brushes, soaps and gels.
January	Project Linus: Blankets for the Nursing Home – Donate new, warm blankets for residents.
February	Furry Friends Collection: Items will be collected for the local animal shelter. Items collected can be dog food, dog treats, dog shampoo, flea spray, or other care items for dogs.
March	Bearable Hugs: Donate new stuffed animals to be given to DFACS for foster children.
April	Hospice Collection: Bring in paper products for hospice care patients in our community.
