4-H SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION, FEBRUARY 11!

Registration for 4-H summer camp begins at 8 a.m. on <u>Friday, February 11</u> at the Lamar County Extension/4-H Office. Spaces are available on a first-come, first served basis.

Cloverleaf Camp will be held at Rock Eagle 4-H Center in Eatonton from June 13-17 for $4^{th} - 6^{th}$ graders. The cost for this camp is \$370. There are 10 spaces available for this camp. Transportation will be provided to and from camp by the Lamar County Extension office UNLESS otherwise instructed due to COVID-19.

Junior Camp will be held at Jekyll 4-H Center in



Brunswick, GA June 27-July 1 for 7th – 8th graders. **The cost for this camp is \$380** (an additional fee for a charter bus to and from camp will be disclosed at a later date. There

are two spaces available for this camp. Transportation to and from the charter bus will not be provided.

Wilderness Challenge Camp will be held in the mountains at Wahsega 4-H Center in Dahlonega for $6^{th}-8^{th}$ graders. The dates for this camp are July 4-8 and July 11-15. **The cost for this camp is \$380**. Transportation to and from this camp will not be provided.

2022 GEORGIA 4-H HORSE SHOW AND EDUCATIONAL CONTESTS

Each year, Georgia 4-H hosts a statewide Horse Show that features everything from halter classes to dressage classes to timed contest events. Georgia 4-H also holds a number of horse-focused educational contests where 4-H'ers can showcase their talent in drawing, painting, method demonstration or public speaking, writing and photography. Students who wish to participate in the Georgia 4-H Horse Show and Educational Contests must be



4th-12th graders (not yet graduated) enrolled in their county 4-H program. Eligibility is determined by grade level during the 2021-2022 school year. A horse or horses that students wish to show must be leased or owned prior to March 1, 2022.

Additionally, students who wish to show a horse or horses must complete Intent to Show Forms and complete specific Georgia 4-H Horseman books.

ONE GEORGIA 4-H URBAN-RURAL AGRICULTURAL EXPERIENCE!

The One Georgia 4-H, an urban-rural 4-H exchange program for students currently in grades 9th – 11th. The program is designed to showcase the importance of agriculture in rural and urban areas of Georgia to students who are considering a career in agriculture.

There will be two very exciting and interactive portions including a Southeastern Georgia session on June

Northeastern
Georgia session on
June 26-28. During
these sessions,
students will tour
rural and urban
areas of Georgia to
visit farms,
restaurants,
research stations,
state agencies, and
more! Students
will be able to gain

knowledge about agriculture and leadership by meeting legislators and other state leaders in agriculture. Students must be available to participate in both program sessions in order to be eligible for the program.

There is an activity fee of \$150 and youth will be responsible for some meals. All applicants must fully complete an online application by March 1 at www.tinyurl.com/onegeorgia2022 for consideration.

One Georgia 4-H is made possible by the generous support of the Thalia and Michael C. Carlos Foundation. Selection notifications will be sent out by March 18 by email. Payment of \$150 will be due to local Extension office by April 8.

Please note: Session 1 (June 1-3) does conflict with Georgia Officer Training for district officers. We encourage students that are running as district officers to still apply if interested! If the student makes board, it would then make them ineligible for One Georgia due to the GOT requirement.
