DIRECTIONS:

- Complete the application form. Please print clearly.
- On a separate sheet of paper, the 4-H'er should write an essay detailing:
 - what 4-H activities you have participated in
 - why you want to attend camp
 - your financial need for a summer camp scholarship

The essay should be handwritten by the 4-H'er.

- Include letter of recommendation from your child's teacher, principal, coach, minister or other adult not related to them with this application. The letter should address the 4-H'ers character, involvement in school and other activities, and how he/she could benefit from attending 4-H Summer Camp.
- Return application and statement to Liberty County 4-H by: March 15, 2018.
- All 4-H'ers requesting camp scholarship money must still complete the 4-H camp registration process. An \$85.00 non-refundable deposit will be due at this time to secure a camp spot for your child.

CRITERIA:

- All scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee.
- Scholarships are awarded based on need and involvement in 4-H activities.
- All scholarship recipients are required to compete in District Project Achievement (DPA).
- Scholarships will be between \$50-\$150.00, unless there are more funds available.
- After scholarships are awarded and accepted, the remainder of camp fees must be paid by May 1, 2018.

All applicants will receive notification by April 3, 2018 if a scholarship will be awarded.
