Cloverleaf and Junior 4-H'ers (grades 4-8) compete locally before advancing to district, while Seniors (grades 9-12) compete at state and national levels with added record-keeping and in-depth project work.

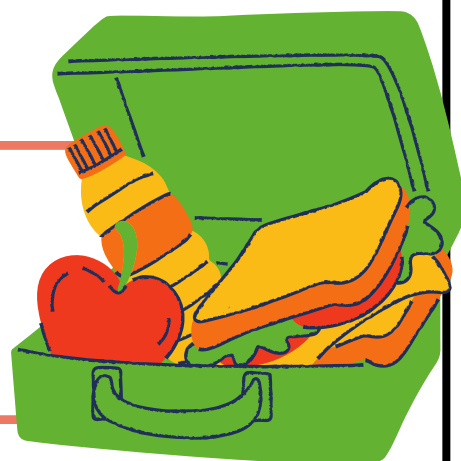
