Points are earned **after** 4-H activities have been completed. **The deadline to complete and hand in materials, for most activities, will be at the class meeting the following month.** Activities listed with an asterisk * take more than one month to complete. To earn points, place all the completed materials in the 4-H Collection Box or Area that your class has prepared OR completed materials may be brought to the 4-H Office 97 Sunset Drive in Danielsville. **Deadline to hand in completed materials to earn points for this club year is May 1st!**



Leadership: points are earned as you complete each area below if you choose to campaign & serve as a club officer
