

Georgia 4-H Peanut Recipe Contest Madison County Extension/4-H Objectives and Guidelines Due: January 4-H Meetings

Objectives:

- To develop leadership abilities, build character, and assume citizenship responsibilities.
- To develop skills for utilizing peanut products creatively in recipes.
- To acquire knowledge of nutritional value and versatility of peanut products.

Guidelines:

Cloverleaf (Grades 4-6):

- Each participant must submit a recipe for his/her favorite peanut butter sandwich in the county contest by the January 4-H Meeting or bring to the 4-H office.
- 2. <u>BEFORE</u> the recipe may be submitted, 4-H'er **must have made the sandwich at home**. Any recipe with inedible items will be disqualified.
- 3. The recipe should **list ingredients yielding I sandwich**, with directions for assembling the sandwich. Recipes can be written or typed on the Georgia 4-H Peanut Recipe Contest Recipe Entry Form or on a separate piece of paper.
- 4. Recipes will be judged on **nutrition**, **appeal**, **creativity**, **recipe presentation**, **recipe content**, **and appropriateness for category**.
- 5. Winners will be selected in a county contest as follows: One Overall Winner and winners in the 3 categories of Most Nutritious, Most Unusual, and Most Creative.

Junior (Grades 7-8):

- I. Each participant must submit a recipe for his/her favorite uncooked snack containing a peanut product to the county contest by the January 4-H Meeting or bring to the 4-H Office.
- 2. The recipe should **yield I serving** and **must include a minimum of either**1/4 cup peanuts (any kind: raw, roasted, salted, dry roasted, chopped or ground); or 2 T. peanut butter or other peanut products. Recipes can be written or typed on the Georgia 4-H Peanut Recipe Contest Recipe Entry Form or on a separate piece of paper.
- Recipes will be judged on **nutrition**, **appeal**, **creativity**, **recipe**presentation, recipe content and appropriateness for category.
- 4. Winners will be selected in a county contest as follows: One Overall Winner and winners in the 3 categories of Most Nutritious, Most Unusual, and Most Creative.
