You will be required to print a certificate of completion and take to your local County Extension Office with the appropriate identification as required by the department of Agriculture <http://agr.georgia.gov/verification-of-lawful-presence.aspx>
The lawful presence affidavit needs to be notarized before coming to your County Extension Office.

Online Exam Instructions:

1. Go to <http://gaprocerts.com>
2. Select "Create New Account"
3. Complete registration form.
4. Verify account by selecting the link provided in the email sent to your account.
5. Enter in "PPE2014" without the quotes when asked for an enrollment key.
6. Review the 12 videos and take the three mini quizzes before taking the final test. The final test will not be available until you have taken all three quizzes.
7. Successfully complete the final test then a certificate of completion will be available via a link at the bottom of the page.
8. Print your certificate and take required identification to your County Extension Office.

Definition of Private Applicator "Private applicator" means any individual who purchases, uses, or supervises the use of any pesticide classified as restricted use for purposes of producing any agricultural or forestry commodity on property owned or rented by him or his employer or, if applied without compensation other than the trading of personal services between producers of agricultural and forestry commodities, on the property of another person.</p>
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In order to obtain a private pesticide applicator's license in Georgia, you must be engaged in the production of an agricultural or forestry commodity. If you obtain this license, you must keep records of restricted use pesticide applications, and are therefore subject to inspections by the Georgia Department of Agriculture and the United States Department of Agriculture. Pesticide labels and all pertinent laws, rules, and regulations must be followed – the misuse of a pesticide in Georgia may result in penalties of \$1000.00 per violation. Verification of Lawful Presence Within United States

(O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1)

The Georgia Department of Agriculture is required by O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1 to verify citizenship/immigration status for all public benefits issued. All public benefits are defined in the law as certifications, licenses, registrations, state grant, etc. All new and renewal licenses are required to complete a notarized affidavit and provide one form of acceptable documentation as defined in O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1. The department will implement this change online no later than July 1, 2013. As directed by law, GDA will utilize the Federal Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security.

A notarized affidavit and one form of acceptable Secure and Verifiable documentation is required by O.C.G.A. § 50-36-1. Secure and Verifiable documents will only need to be submitted one time. Companies will only have to resubmit when their respected ownership changes.

Where can I get my affidavit notarized?

- Contact your local town or city hall.
- Visit an official court near your location.
- Check your banking or financial institution.
- Research your local notary options online.
- Contact your insurance company to determine if it has a notary you can use.
