## What to Bring to 4-H Camp at Rock Eagle

# Everything should be marked in the child's name with a waterproof marker. Do not bring jewelry or other items of value

#### Items to Bring:

- Waterproof sunscreen (very important)
- Linens, blankets or sleeping bag (linens are NOT provided at camp)
- Pillow (optional)
- Daily change of clothes and underwear (shorts, tee shirts, etc.
  Pack clothes that can get dirty and sandy!)
- Shoes and Socks (bring at least 2 pairs—one that can get wet and muddy)
- Towels (wash cloth, shower towels and beach/pool towels)
- Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, and other toiletries
- Bathing suits, please make sure these are both modest and appropriate
- Rain jacket
- Sunglasses and/or hat
- Money for canteen
- Plastic garbage bag for wet clothes
- Insect Repellent
- Money for lunch for bus trip to and from camp as needed.
  Please contact your county office for this information.

#### Optional Items

- Day Pack
- Sport Sandals (the kind with a heel strap is <u>strongly</u> recommended)
- Water Bottle
- Camera (if using a film rather than a digital camera, use of disposables is recommended, mark your full name on camera)
- Shower Shoes
- Pen, paper, stamps

### **DO NOT BRING:**

- Knives
- Media Devices
- Shaving cream
- Fireworks
- Chewing gum
- Excessive amount of cash or items of great value (emotional or monetary)

## Clothing guidelines:

- 1. No clothing should be worn that violates the Code of Conduct.
- 2. Underwear should always be worn and should not be visible.
- 3. Camp is rough on clothes—bring only clothes that are okay to get wet or muddy.
- 4. Bring extra socks and underwear—you always need them!

All items should be marked with the child's name on the inside of clothing
