General Information:

- Archery team is open to 5th 12th grade students in Paulding County (Public, Private, Home School)
- Paulding County 4-H Archery information meeting: Sunday, September 7, 2025 at 3:00
 PM, Paulding County Parks and Recreation
 Department, 210 Paulding Ln, Dallas, GA 30132
- Registration for <u>returning archers</u>: August 4 – 15, 2025
- Registration for <u>new archers</u>: September 8 – 12, 2025
- Archers 8th grade and up will be asked to participate in the Paulding 4-H Teen Leader Training that will be conducted in Spring 2026.
- Archer Safety Meeting: Sunday, September 14, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. (Archery field at the Paulding County Extension Office)

- The team will be capped at 35 archers. In the event that interest exceeds enrollment capacity, a lottery system may be put in place.
- Archers in 7th 12th grade will be required to complete a Hunter's Safety Course. Details will be provided after registration closes.
- Enrollment card and Medical Information & Release form (MIRF) are required at registration.
- Code of Conduct (expected 4-H behavior) will be sent via email after registration is complete.

Activity Fee:

- \$150.00 per year (\$25 off for second child) **Due NLT Friday, October 24, 2025**
- Payments cannot be paid at practices
- Payment can be made at the Extension Office with cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or money order

- **Deadline for activity refunds:** October 31, 2025. All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee.

Equipment: Archers are responsible for the purchase of their own equipment to include: bow, arrows, arm guard, finger protection and quiver. We have a several team bows, but they are only available for students to use during the first few practices. They are different draws and are designed for younger shooters.

- This is NOT a drop off club. Each shooter needs at least one parent/guardian to stay with them at each practice and competition.
- Parents are encouraged to become screened volunteers. This allows parents to chaperone events or help other shooters at practice. Follow the below link to start the process.
