Welcome potential shooters and families,

We look forward to new members joining our team for the 2024/2025 season. A little about us, we are a volunteer run club headed by two coaches. This is a competitive shooting team where we group kids into 5-7 shooter teams. Each child is scored individually and the scores are totaled to make a team score. Each shooter has the opportunity to place in competitions individually or as a team depending on their final scores/team total score. General Information:

- BB team is open to 4th 9th grade students in Paulding County (Public, Private, Home School)
- Paulding County 4-H BB information meeting:
 Wednesday, September 18, 2024 at 6:30 PM at the Paulding County Extension Office (530 W. Memorial Drive, Dallas, GA 30132)
- Registration: September 30 October 4, 2024
- Enrollment and medical forms are due upon registration
- Code of Conduct (expected 4-H behavior) agreement will be sent via email after registration is complete
- Gun assembly will be provided to new shooters at practice
- Parents are encouraged to become screened volunteers. This allows parents to chaperone events or help other shooters at practices.

• This is NOT a drop off club. Each shooter needs at least one parent/guardian to stay with them at each practice and competition

- The team is capped at 16 shooters. In the event that interest exceeds enrollment capacity, a lottery system may be put in place

Activity Fee / Registration:

- \$150.00 per year **Due NLT October 25, 2024**
- Payment can be made at the Extension Office with cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or money order
- Make all checks payable to Paulding County
 4-H
- Payments can be phoned into the Extension Office with a Visa/MasterCard at 770-443-7616
- Payments cannot be paid at practices
- Deadline for activity refunds is November 1, 2024. All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee

Equipment: Each shooter will need a Daisy 499 rifle and parents are responsible for the purchase of the rifle. Please call Daisy Outdoors at 479-636-1200 to place your order. The cost will be around \$150.00 after shipping.

Practices:

- Practices will be held at the JROTC range at Hiram Highs School on Ballentine road on Mondays from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm
- The season goes from November early May and then May – July for the Nationals qualifying shooters
- One parent is required to stay during practice
- The first practice for new shooters is October 15, 2024
- The first practice for returning shooters is October 29, 2024
- A practice schedule will be posted with both mandatory and optional practices marked.
