We look forward to new members joining our team for the 2025/2026 season. We are a volunteer run club that is headed by two coaches. This is a competitive shooting team where we group kids into 5-7 shooter teams. Each child is scored individually and the scores are totaled to make a team score. Each shooter has the opportunity to place individually or as a team during completions, depending on their final scores/team total score. ### General Information:

- BB team is open to 4th - 9th grade students in Paulding County (Public, Private, Home School)
- Paulding County 4-H BB information meeting:

**Location: Paulding County Parks and Recreation Complex (210 Paulding Lane, Dallas, GA 30132)**
- Registration: September 29 – October 3, 2025
- Enrollment and medical forms are due upon registration
- Code of Conduct (expected 4-H behavior) agreement will be sent via email after registration is complete
- Gun assembly will be provided to new shooters at practice
- Parents are encouraged to become screened volunteers. This allows parents to chaperone events or help other shooters at practices. Follow the below link to start the process to become a screened volunteer:

- The team is capped at 20 shooters. In the event that interest exceeds enrollment capacity, a lottery system will be put in place

### Activity Fee / Registration:

- \$150.00 per year  
**Due NLT October 24, 2025**
- Payment can be made at the Extension Office with cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or money order
- Make all checks payable to **Paulding County 4-H**
- Payment can be phoned into the Extension Office with a Visa/MasterCard at 770-443-7616
- Payment **cannot** be paid at practices
- Deadline for activity refunds is **October 31, 2025**. *All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee*

**Equipment:** Each shooter will need a Daisy 499 rifle and parents are responsible for the purchase of the rifle. Please call Daisy Outdoors at 479-636-1200 to place your order. The cost will be around \$150.00 after shipping.

## Practices:

- Practices will be held at the Hiram High School JROTC range on Ballentine road
- Practices are conducted on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm
- The season lasts from October through early May, and then May – July for shooters that qualify for Nationals
- One parent is required to stay during practice
- The first practice for new shooters is Tuesday, October 14, 2025
- The first practice for returning shooters is Tuesday, October 28, 2025
- A practice schedule will be posted that includes mandatory and optional practices

- The Project SAFE State BB match will be held at Rock Eagle 4-H Center located in Eatonton, GA on April 24-26, 2026.
