4-H Oral Presentation Rubric

- ✓ Pick a topic **YOU'RE** interested in. (See back page) →
- ✓ Research your topic.
 - ✓ Write your speech on **note cards** (2 points)
 - ✓ Include:
 - an **introduction** that includes your name (2 – 3 sentences) (3 points)
 - **3 important facts with explanations** (3- 4 sentences **per** fact) (9 Points)
 - a **career** that relates to your topic (2-3 sentences which includes **education, salary, and how it is beneficial to your topic area**) (6 points)
 - a **conclusion** (2-3 sentences) (3 points)
- ✓ Make a poster or Tri-fold with **LARGE text** and **pictures** (2 points)
- ✓ **Time yourself!** Your presentation should be at least **3 minutes - 4 minutes MAXIMUM!**

GO FOR THE EXTRA POINTS!!!

Include an introduction hook, make pictures stand out on your poster, wear something that matches your presentation, bring in visual aids and **BE EXCITED!**
