- ◆ Include an **introduction** with your name and topic.
- ◆ Note **3 important facts**. Explain with 3-4 sentences each.
- ◆ Relate your topic to a **career**. Tell us about education, salary, and how it is beneficial to your topic area.
- ◆ End with a fun or thoughtful **conclusion**.
- ◆ Make a poster or Tri-fold with **LARGE text** and **pictures**
- ◆ Use note cards and try not to read from your poster.
- ◆ **Time yourself!** Aim for **3 minutes - 4 minutes!**
