Georgia 4-H Summer Camp at Burton 4-H Center on Tybee Island is a week-long experience that includes visits to the beach, dolphin cruise, beach ecology plus many other exciting activities. The Burton 4-H Center is located on a 6-acre hammock surrounded by acres of salt marsh at the end of Lewis Avenue on Tybee Island, GA. Tybee Island is the northernmost barrier island in Georgia. Connected to the mainland by Highway 80, Tybee Island is approximately 15 miles east of the historic town of Savannah, Georgia.

Camp registration is now open! The cost of camp includes lodging, food, transportation, insurance, a 4-H camp t-shirt, and all activities. There are a limited number of spaces available. Our new online registration portal now accepts major credit cards as payment for camp!
