

2: Create

Step 2: Research, write, & design your presentation!

Start by creating an essay about your topic. After that, design & make your Google Slides or Posters!



Do you know what pictures you want to have on your posters?



Recipe for the Perfect DPA Speech

Introduction: This is where you will hook your audience, introduce yourself, and tell what your topic is

Descriptive Words: Be sure to use adjectives to fully describe what you are talking about so your judges can clearly understand your topic


Body: This is the three big points where you will share facts about your topic

Visual Theme: Make sure your Google Slides or Posters are attractive

Expression: Speak loud and clear while giving your speech

Conclusion: This is where you summarize your 3 big points, refer back to your introduction hook, and thank the audience






Get Specific!



Your project area has a ton of different topics within it! Narrow down your topic using the "Pencil Method" so that you can present about something specific!

Here is an example:









For example, this presentation could explain why football helmets, pads, and cleats are important!



3 parts to a DPA Speech: **Introduction, Body, Closing** Use the provided speech template to make writing your speech super easy! Your finished speech should be 3-4 minutes long!





Design Your Visuals

Create Google Slides, PowerPoint Slides, Posters, or a Tri-fold Display to SHOW what your project is about.

Design your Slides/Posters

A completed project includes your SPEECH & VISUAL DISPLAY. Your Visuals may be in the form of Google Slides, PowerPoint Slides, Poster Boards, or a Tri-Board display. Make sure your key points are shared on your visuals. If you need help making your visual aids, please call the 4-H Office! We can help with Slides, PPT, and posters for free!

Completed projects (Speech & Visuals) are due to the 4-H Office BEFORE February 28th. We will work with you to video all presentations BEFORE March 19th.
