UGA Cooperative Extension in Hart County continues a long tradition of supporting local farmers and families. The Agriculture and Natural Resources agent provides individual consultations, laboratory testing, nutrient management planning and a variety of educational workshops annually. A few of the workshops offered this past year included the Gardening Lunch and Learn series, Help on the Homestead series, Small Ruminant Parasite Workshop, Forage Field Day and Unlocking Farm Resources. Youth development programs continue to build life skills in our students. Over 450 students broaden their skills in research, writing, record keeping and public speaking through 4-H Project Fair competition. Sixty-five of those students went on to showcase those skills at District Project Achievement. Thirty-four youth expanded their decision making and critical thinking skills while learning specific content-based material as part of one of our three judging teams: Forestry, Cotton Boll and Consumer, and Dairy Quiz Bowl. Other skills touched on through this past year of programming included leadership, service and volunteering, social skills, teamwork and self-responsibility in hopes of contributing to the development of well-rounded, productive citizens.
