Educational Minibooths: Create a freestanding minibooth on any subject

Recycling: Create an item using recycled items- glass, metal, paper, plastic, or any other material

Decorated Agricultural Products: Create an item using dried, non-perishable agriculture products- gourds, dried corn, peanuts, etc. Exhibits no larger than 24" in any direction
