Plants will be available for pick-up on March 15th from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. at the Tattnall County High School Livestock Barn. Some plants are over 3' high, so we recommend pick-up in a truck if you have trees in your order. If driving a smaller vehicle, you may wish to bring some plastic bags to cover pots so dirt doesn't spill in floor boards. If special arrangements are needed for pick-up, they must be pre-scheduled with the Extension staff. No refunds will be given for plants that are not picked up on the assigned pick-up date.
