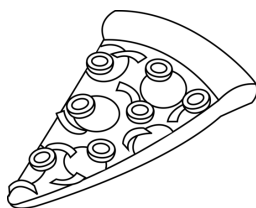
4-H T-Shirts

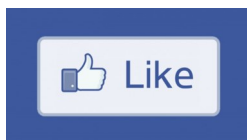
Pizza in the Park
